- Classroom support
- Additional software and hardware

In exchange for receiving the items above, you will be expected to:

- Attend all of the following meetings/workshops from 3:15 – 4:45 p.m. (Nov. 19, Dec. 13, Jan. 14, Feb. 4, Mar. 10, Apr. 21, May 19, June 9). *Please check your calendar to be certain that you are available. Attendance at all meetings/workshops is **required**.*
- Create a minimum of two finished videos - one “practice video” that we will work on together and one “polished video” that will be submitted into our own Project SAVI Film Festival.
- Be open to having an Instructional Technology Facilitator come to your classroom for assistance and support

We will select as many participants as we can (schools can fund additional participants, if they choose). All teachers are encouraged to apply. Participants are expected to have experience using an Apple Macintosh computer.
