### Myths vs. Facts

- ◆ The flu shot can give me the flu —MYTH
- Flu viruses used in flu shots are inactivated, so they cannot cause infection —FACT
- Vaccines are not proven to prevent the flu—MYTH
- If you get the flu vaccine, you are about 60% less likely to need treatment for the flu—FACT
- I should wait to get vaccinated so that I'm covered through the end of the season—MYTH
- People should get a flu shot as soon as they are available because it takes about two weeks for antibodies to develop—FACT

# Good Health Habits

In addition to getting your flu shot, it is always helpful to maintain good health habits to prevent future illness. These include, but are not limited to:

- Wash your hands frequently.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
- Clean and disinfect surfaces and objects in your home and workplace.



# 2016 / 2017 Flu Season "What You Need to Know"

#### Do not have a flu shot if:

- You have a fever
- You are ill
- You have had a serious reaction to a flu shot in the past
- You are allergic to eggs or egg product
- You have a history of Guillain-Barre Syndrome

#### See your Health Care Provider for your Flu Immunization if:

- You are pregnant or think you may be pregnant
- You are a nursing mother
- You are under 18 years of age

#### This year's flu strains are:

an A/California/7/2009 (H1N1)pdm09-like virus an A/Hong Kong/4801/2014 (H3N2)-like virus a B/Brisbane/60/2018-like virus. (This is a B/Victoria lineage virus)

#### Note:

- 1. Please wear a "short" sleeve shirt or blouse on the day of the shots.
- 2. The flu vaccine is made from a virus that is no longer active. Therefore, you cannot get the flu from a flu shot.
