Art Show Submission Procedures

Welcome to another art show season. GGUSD students have the opportunity to submit pieces for the First Impressions Student Art Exhibit and The Imagination Celebration of Orange County. Artwork submitted for our district show (First Impressions) will automatically get sent on to the Orange County show (Imagination Celebration 1000 Pieces of Art Show) unless requested otherwise. As of last year, OCDE is in charge of running the IC show. They have decided to go with an online submission/label process using Google Forms. We will use these labels for our show as well. This new process will cut down on the extensive data input that normally goes along with this show each year. Each piece submitted needs to have a form filled out. Any artwork that is not submitted online and does not have a label properly completed will be returned. The online digital submission form can be located here:

After filling out the form, the label will get emailed to you in a PDF format. The format of the printed label is not quite as user friendly as previous labels, but with some folding/cutting they will work. Like in the past, 3D artwork should have labels attached where it makes sense and is easily accessible. The placement of labels on 2D artwork will remain relatively the same as well. Please <u>do not</u> glue the labels onto the mats of the 2D artwork. (Despite what the IC guidelines say)
