He expressed his gratitude for the Garden Grove Police Department and Fire Department for their service to the community and schools, and for keeping the community abreast of current events. Trustee Reed gave her thanks to the high school administrators, athletic directors, coaches, and student athletes for coming this evening to represent and show support for their schools and sports.

Trustee Harden commented that he was pleased to see that leaders in the community were able to sort through the issues which prevented the district from participating in last year's Tet parade.

Trustee Lan Nouven thanked administration and staff at Ralston for keeping the student's safe during a recent lockdown. He thanked Dr. West for the idea of having the student athletes come to a Board meeting. He reported on his attendance at several parent meetings and noted the need to have their input especially now with new programs coming. He wished all a happy new year, good health, and prosperity.

Chairperson West thanked the superintendent and staff for their participation in the strategic plan meetings with parents and community members.
