Chairperson West opened closed session at 4:45 p.m. to receive comments from the public limited to Closed Session the item described herein. There were no comments from the public and closed session commenced at 4:50 p.m. to discuss anticipated litigation with the Superintendent, Larry Ferchaw (Consultant -Dolinka Group), and Mark Bresee (Counsel - Atkinson, Andelson, Loya, Rudd and Romo) (one potential case) (Government Code Section 54956.9(d)(2)and(e)(1); and (2) superintendent's evaluation with the Superintendent (Government Code Section 54957). No action was taken in closed session. Closed session was adjourned at 6:55 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson West at 7:01 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Call to Order Allegiance.

Linda Cone. Lorri Kaylor. Tom Pollitt, and Eric Stoelting addressed the Board with their comments Public Comments and concerns regarding Common Core.

Hearing no comments or corrections, Chairperson West declared the Minutes of the July 22, 2014, Minutes Approved Regular Board Meeting approved as submitted.

Chairperson West opened the public hearing pursuant to Education Code Sections 60119, 60422(b). Public Hearing 60605, and 33126 related to the determination and certification that each pupil in the district has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials that are aligned to content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Sections 60605 and 33126 in each subject as appropriate, and that they are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the State Board of Education. There were no comments from the public and the hearing was closed.

Larry Ferchaw (Consultant - Dolinka Group) and Mark Bresee (Counsel - Atkinson, Andelson, Loya, Presentation – Public Rudd and Romo) presented to the Board an overview of Board Trustee Areas.

Amy Stevens, Public Information Officer, introduced Steven Pomeroy from Pacifica High School, the 2014-15 Student Board of Education Representative to the Board of Education.
