CLUB NAME	SCHOOL	DESCRIPTION
Academic Decathlon	Bolsa Grande, Garden Grove, and La Quinta	It is a statewide non-profit organization that promotes an educational experience providing a format in which teams of nine students compete in academic events. The team must include three A students, three B students, and three C students. The students take 30 minute multiple choice tests in the subjects of Economics, Art, Music, Language and Literature, Mathematics, and Social Science.
Ambassador's Club	Garden Grove and Pacifica	This club serves the school and community through leadership and dedication. Members receive information on ways to get involved in school, about colleges and how to succeed academically.
American Red Cross	Bolsa Grande, Garden Grove, La Quinta, Los Amigos, Pacifica, and Rancho Alamitos	Helps students work together, develop leadership skills and make their communities and the world a better place.
Associated Student Body (ASB)	Garden Grove, La Quinta, Bolsa Grande, Los Amigos, Santiago, Pacifica, and Rancho Alamitos	The ASB members promote school spirit and service to the school and community. Members are elected or appointed.
Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID)	Bolsa Grande, Garden Grove, Los Amigos Rancho Alamitos, Pacifica and Santiago	Student selection focuses on students in the middle (2.0-3.50) with academic potential who would benefit from AVID support to improve their academic record and begin preparation for college.
California Scholastic Federation (CSF)	Garden Grove, Los Amigos, Santiago, Rancho Alamitos, Pacifica, and La Quinta	CSF promotes scholarship and service. Members who meet demanding academic criteria may graduate with a gold cord (which represents the honor and distinguishes them from other graduates). Members raise funds for scholarships and field trips. At the club meetings, they receive information on colleges, scholarships, and additional educational opportunities.
Environmental/Ecology Club	Garden Grove, Pacifica, Rancho Alamito, La Quinta and Santiago	This club provides recycling services to the school, beach clean-ups, and trips to nature centers. Members will perform community service to help the environment and educate peers about their effect on our planet.

Membership in these clubs is open to any student who is currently studying the language.

Key Club	Bolsa Grande, Garden Grove, La Quinta, Rancho Alamitos, Los Amigos, Pacifica, and Santiago	Key Club is a community service organization designed to provide a variety of opportunities for students to develop leadership skills, serve the school and community, and prepare students to be useful citizens. The club is open to all students in grades 9-12.
Link Crew	Bolsa Grande	Link Crew is built on the belief that students can help students' success. As positive role models, Link members are motivators, leaders, and teachers who guide freshmen to discover what it takes to be successful in high school.
Mecha Club	La Quinta, Garden Grove, and Santiago	This club is intended to promote higher education and respect diversity. It teaches cultural awareness. The members also do community service by adopting a family during Thanksgiving and providing Christmas stockings during the holidays.
Mock Trial or Debate	Garden Grove, La Quinta and Pacifica	Students have an opportunity to examine the legal system, learn relevant laws, dissect cases, apply persuasive arguments to cases, and compete against other area high schools.
National Honor Society (NHS)	Bolsa Grande, Garden Grove, La Quinta, Pacifica, Rancho Alamitos and Santiago	National Honor Society members are selected based on academic performance and outstanding citizenship. They fulfill vows to uphold the qualities of leadership, honor, scholarship, and service during their junior and senior years by maintaining excellent grades, a clean conduct record, and by finding ways to lead others in service to the community.
Student League	Garden Grove, La Quinta, Bolsa Grande, Los Amigos, Santiago, Pacifica, and Rancho	Members participate in school and community activities such as charity walks, canned food drives, and organizing Thanksgiving baskets for needy families during the holiday season.
