No.	Common Name	Specie Name	Description	Mature Height
2	<b>California Poppy</b>	<i>Eschscholzia California</i>	Pale yellow to deep orange. Flowers spring to summer and reseeds easily. Blossoms close at night. Plant seeds in fall on well-drained soil. Little irrigation required. Full sun.	12" to 24" tall
3	<b>Dusty Miller</b>	<i>Artemisia stellerana</i>	Grown mostly for its aromatic silvery foliage, the texture and color contrasts presented by the various types makes them invaluable garden perennials and herbs.	12" to 24" tall
4	<b>Festuca</b>	<i>Festuca ovina glauca</i>	A handsome and different ground cover. Grows in grassy, tuft-like clumps. The spectacular, non-fading foliage and unique growing habits make this ideal for border.	6" to 12" tall
5	<b>Fountain Grass</b>	<i>Pennisetum lopecurooides</i>	Flowing tufts of bright green foliage are topped by arching 5-7" white flower spikes that last well into winter.	24" to 36" tall
6	<b>Gardenia</b>	<i>Gardenia jasminoides</i>	They are evergreen shrubs with broad, dark green, glossy and leathery texture leaves. The flowers are solitary or in small clusters, white, or pale yellow, with a tubular-based corolla. Flowering is from about mid-spring to mid-summer and many species are strongly scented. They do well in shady areas and are consider a hardy plant.	48" to 96" tall
7	<b>Garlic Plant, Purple Sensation</b>	<i>Ornamental Allium/ Allium hollandicum</i>	The tall flowers of 'Purple Sensation' appear in summer, showing off rounded heads full of deep violet flowers. These alliums are perfect for a sunny border.	12" to 36" tall

No.	Common Name	Specie Name	Description	Mature Height
8	<b>Golden Euonymus</b>	<i>Euonymus japonicus</i> 'Ovatus Aureus'	Evergreen shrub with large, glossy, oval shaped leaves that are dark forest green and broadly edged in bright golden yellow. Fast grower - good for use as a colorful hedge, or as a brilliant accent plant. Can handle a wide variety of conditions. Will even do well in coastal areas, but prefers full sun with average moisture. Some branches and leaves are solid yellow with no green whatsoever, making this plant a real standout. Can be maintained at virtually any height, shape, or size with pruning/trimming. Brilliant colors, and easy to grow.	48" to 72" tall
9	<b>Heavenly Bamboo</b>	<i>Nandina domestica</i>	An evergreen shrub not related to bamboo plants. Flowers bloom in the summer, foliage changes to bright red or orange in the fall, and small red berries appear in the winter.	48" to 96" tall
10	<b>Iceberg Roses</b>	<i>Rosa sp 'Iceberg'</i>	This plant is upright with light green foliage. They have wonderful, pure white flowers in early summer followed by sporadic repeats all summer creating a long bloom season. They also have a mildly sweet fragrance that accompanies them during each bloom	24" to 48" tall
11	<b>Indian Hawthorns</b>	<i>Raphiolepis indica</i>	Bushy and spreading evergreen shrub with oval to lance-shaped, deeply toothed, shiny dark green leaves. Panicles of white flowers with pink centers bloom in spring or summer. Grow in sheltered border. Doesn't like cold, drying winds. Prefers moist, well-drained soil in full sun.	36" to 72" tall
12	<b>Japanese Pittosporum</b>	<i>Pittosporum tobira</i>	Glossy, dark green leaves, easy care, and a natural mounding shape shrub. Clusters of creamy white flowers appear in spring, with a fragrance similar to orange blossoms.	96" to 144" tall

13	<b>Lily of the Nile</b>	<i>Agapanthus praecox</i>	Clusters of large, blue, funnel-shaped flowers appear atop long stalks in summer and early fall, rising above the coarse, strap-like, green leaves.	24" to 48" tall
14	<b>Marguerite Daisy</b>	<i>Chrysanthemum frutescens</i>	The Chrysanthemum frutescent plants are around three feet high and have solidly green leaves with a delicate or fine texture. They are often treated as a bush although they do not grow very high. It will produce blooms for three seasons.	24" to 42" tall
15	<b>Mexican Feather Grass</b>	<i>Nassella tenuissima</i>	Cascading fountain-like. The wiry, slender, hair-like leaves are green and silky in the spring and buff colored during the winter.	12" to 24" tall
16	<b>Mexican Sage Plant</b>	<i>Salvia leucantha</i>	Mexican Sage is a bushy evergreen shrub. It is a lovely perennial bush that produces velvety purple calyx and white or purple flowers in late-summer. It grows in a loose, spreading mound up to 2-4 ft tall and about the same width. The leaves are lance shaped, like willow leaves, long, puckery on top and white-wooly underneath.	24" to 48" tall
17	<b>Mojave Sage</b>	<i>Salvia pachyphylla</i>	Among the most beautiful of the sages, Mojave sage offers beautiful pink blooms that look good well into fall. Even when not in bloom, its gray-green foliage is lovely. Like other salvias, it's great for hummingbirds and butterflies. And it's a great cut flower.	24" to 36" tall

18	<b>New Zealand Flax</b>	<i>Phormium</i>	A perennial evergreen that has large long strapped leaves in shades of green, bronze and maroon. Striking rigid, sword like leaves provides an impressive vertical accent to any garden. Clump-forming. Foliage can have rigid upright to gracefully arching habits.	48" to 72" tall
19	<b>Podocarpus</b>	<i>Podocarpus</i>	The Podocarpus is a medium size evergreen shrub plant with dense upright branching on pyramidal form. The Podocarpus Evergreen Shrub Plant is heavily covered by dark green yew like leaves.	72" to 96" tall
20	<b>Privet</b>	<i>Ligustrum texanum</i>	The Ligustrum shrub plant produces spectacular displays of white blooms and is a useful hedge. The plant forms densely branched, glossy foliage that provides as great dividers.	36" to 84" tall
